



THE MEASUREMENTS

38"/96.5cm by 38"/96.5cm

THE GAUGE

20 sts and 20 rows = 4"/10cm in garter stitch (I used a US 5 but I am a loose knitter)

THE PATS

Stripe Sequence 1

4 rows each Group 1
10 rows each Group 2
6 rows each Group 3
4 rows each Group 1
10 rows each Group 2
6 rows each Group 3

Stripe Sequence 2

4 rows each Group 3
10 rows each Group 2
6 rows each Group 1
4 rows each Group 3
10 rows each Group 2
6 rows each Group 1

MITERED SQUARES

(make 2 using Stripe Sequence I and 2 using Stripe Sequence II)

With A, cast on 161 sts,

Row 1 (RS) K79, pm, SK2P (slip 1, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over), k79—159 sts.

Row 2 Knit.

Row 3 K77, move marker up one st, SK2P, k to end—157 sts.

Rep rows 2 and 3 moving marker up 1 st and dec'ing 2 sts each RS row until 3 stitches remain.

Next row (RS) SK2P, fasten off.

FINISHING

Using photo for reference, arrange square with cast-on edge pointed towards the center or as desired. Sew together using mattress stitch. Trim borders in 2 rows single crochet in the color of your choice (we thought the baby was going to be a boy, hence the blue on Juniper's blanket).

WASH!

For a carriage version, make 2 squares instead of 4. w

JUNIPER'S GINORMOUS BABY BLANKET (IT'S REALLY JUST A SIMPLE MITERED BLANKET) STUFF

I used a discontinued cashmere by Filatura di Crosa but any dk weight merino such as Zara will do.

GROUP 1

A Red, B Berry, C Melon, D Orange

GROUP 2

E Lemon, F Pea green, G Grass, H Aqua

GROUP 3

I Blue, J Periwinkle, K Purple, L Fuchsia

Approx 300yd/274.5m each color
