



SUN UMBRELLA

STUFF

16 balls in #770-124 Ecru of Lion Crochet Cotton by Lion Brand Yarn, 3.30oz./94g balls, each approx 400yd/360m (cotton)

One size H-8 (5mm) crochet hook OR SIZE TO GET THE GAUGE

Tapestry needle

THE MEASUREMENTS

15"/38cm wide to bottom of fringe x 18 ft/5.5m long.

Note Sized for octagon patio umbrella approx 216"/548cm circumference. For smaller or larger umbrella circumference, work pat to desired length, adding 6"/15.5cm for ease.

THE GAUGE

19 sts and 4 rows to 4"/10cm over dc using size H-8 (5mm) crochet hook and 4 strands held tog.

BE SURE TO GET THE GAUGE.

THE STITCH

Dtr double treble crochet (U.K. – triple treble)

BL back loop

NOTES

- 1) Use 4 strands throughout.
- 2) Border trim is worked sideways.

MAKE THE BORDER

With 4 strands held tog, ch 20.

Row 1 Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across—19 sc. Ch 15 for loop and turn to work into foundation chain.

Row 2 Dtr in 1st ch, ch 2, skip 2 ch, dtr in next ch, [ch 2, skip 2 ch, tr in next ch] twice, [ch 2, skip 2 ch, dc in next ch] twice, ch 2, skip 2 ch, sc in last ch. Ch 1, turn.

Row 3 Sc in first st, [ch 2, skip ch-2 sp, sc in next st] 6 times. Ch 1, turn.

Row 4 Sc in first sc, [ch 2, skip ch-2 sp, dc in next sc] twice, [ch 2, skip ch-2 sp, tr in next sc] twice, [ch 2, skip ch-2 sp, dtr in next sc] twice. Ch 1, turn.

Row 5 Rep row 3. Ch 15, turn.

Row 6 Dtr in 1st st, ch 2, skip 2 sts, dtr in next st, [ch 2, skip 2 sts, tr in next st] twice, [ch 2, skip 2 sts, dc in next st] twice, ch 2, skip 2 sts, sc in last st. Ch 1, turn.

Rep rows 3-6 for pat until there are 80 ch-15 lps, placing marker at top edge of border every 10 lps. End pat with row 4. Do not fasten off.

MAKE BORDER EDGING

Turn border 90 degrees to work along top edge. Ch 2, *5 hdc in dtr sp, hdc in next 3 sc posts; rep from * around. Join with sl st to first hdc. Fasten off.

MAKE CORKSCREW FRINGE

Attach yarn to bottom sc of row 1. Ch 1, *9 sc in ch-15 lp, (ch 41, work in BL only, sc in 2nd ch and in next 9 ch, [2 sc in next ch, sc in next ch] 15 times), sl st in last sc worked, rep bet () once more, 9 sc in ch-15 lp, sc in side of ch 1 at beg row 4; rep from * for each ch-15 lp, ending last lp with sc in edge of trim. Fasten off.

ATTACH TO UMBRELLA

Weave in ends. With RS facing, pin trim to umbrella edge matching stitch markers with octagon points, easing to fit. With 2 strands of yarn and working from inside of umbrella, sew top edge of trim to inside hem. Sew edges together from WS. Fasten off. (C)
