



TwoTimers Scarf Patterns

The nice thing about scarves is that they are easy to customize, making them as wide or as long as you like. To work the scarves from the stitch patterns featured in our TwoTimers article, just read on.

FINDING THE STITCH MULTIPLE

The stitch multiple is usually noted at the beginning of a pattern. For example, #4 Seeded Rib has a multiple of "4 sts + 3". The 4 sts are the ones that are repeated after the asterisk (*); the "+ 3" are extra stitches that center the pattern. You can work the pattern over any number of stitches that equals the multiple plus the extra stitches, such as

15 (4 x 3 = 12, + 3) or 23 (4 x 5 = 20, + 3 = 23).

Let's start with the simplest multiple. "Worked over any number of sts" means just that, any number of stitches will do. In the case of #1 Two-Color Garter St pat, the row sequence forms the pattern. Work a gauge swatch at least 4" in width and length.

To determine the stitch gauge, measure the width of your swatch, and divide that measurement by the number of stitches. Our swatch for #1 measured 7" across, worked over 28 sts, giving 4 sts to the inch (28 sts divided by 7" = 4 sts to the inch). Working with the same yarn and gauge as our swatch, cast on 32 sts to make an 8" wide scarf (8 x 4 = 32), for a 10" wide scarf cast on 40 sts (10 x 4 = 40).

Next in difficulty would be "worked over an even (or odd) number of sts". For #6 Simple Brioché, an even number of sts is required. Cast on an even number of sts, and work a swatch at least 4" in width and in length. Our swatch measured 7½" across, worked over 30 sts, giving 4 stitches to the inch (30 sts divided by 7½" = 4 sts to the inch). Working with the same yarn and gauge as our swatch, cast on 32 sts to make an 8" wide scarf, for a 10" wide scarf, cast on 40 sts.

A multiple of 12 sts plus 4, as in #5 4-St Garter and 4 x 4 Reversible Cables,

would also take an even number of sts. Our swatch measured 6" over 40 sts, giving 6.75 sts to the inch (40 sts divided by 6" = 6.66 sts, rounded to 6.75 to the inch). The 12-st multiple is worked 3 times, for 36 sts, plus the 4 extra sts to make 40 sts. Working with the same yarn and gauge as our swatch, cast on 52 sts (4 x 12-st multiple = 48 sts, + 4 = 52 sts) to make an 7¾" wide scarf (52 sts divided by 6.75 sts per inch = 7.70"), for a 10" wide scarf, cast on 68 sts (5 x 12-st multiple = 60 sts, + 8 = 68 sts).

THE DOUBLE KNITS

Reading the gauge in the Double Knit Patterns #8–12 is a little more involved. It can be hard to determine the stitch gauge because alternate sts face front and back.

You must count the sts that face out on both sides of the swatch and divide by the width.

To get an accurate gauge over a double knit pattern, cast on the multiple as specified in the pattern. For #11 Double-Knit Stripes and Dots, a multiple of 4 sts plus 1, cast on at least 37 sts (36 + 1). Repeat rows 1–8, do not bind off. It will be helpful to refer to the number of stitches on the holder. Be sure to knit at least 4" length, as this type of stitch will pull in, changing the stitch gauge. Once you have worked for a few inches, you'll get an accurate reading.

Slip the stitches to a holder, lay the swatch flat. Each side of the swatch appears to have 9 repeats of 2 sts, + 1 st, which would equal 19 sts. But if you stretch out the swatch, you'll see the back of the 2 knit sts that face on the other side.

Measure across the swatch for the width of each rep. On our 37-st swatch, each 4-st rep measures ½", the entire swatch measures 4¾" (9 x ½" = 4 ½", + 1 st = 4¾"). The stitch gauge is 8 stitches to the inch.

Working with the same yarn and gauge as our swatch, cast on 65 sts (8 x 8 = 64, + 1) to make an 8" wide scarf, for a 10" wide scarf cast on 81 sts (10 x 8 = 80, + 1).

STUFF

#111835 Purple (A) of Deluxe Worsted by Universal Yarn, Inc., 3½oz/100g skein, each approx 220yd/201m (wool)

#10 Dazzling (B) of Rebecca by Universal Yarn, Inc., 1¼ oz/50g skein, each approx 70yd/64m

(polyamide/acrylic/mohair)

Two size 9 (5.5mm) double pointed needles (dpns) OR one circular needle OR SIZE TO GET THE GAUGE

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 8 (10, 12)"/20 (25.5, 30.5)cm wide, knit to desired length.

GAUGE

16 sts and 30 rows to 4"/10cm over pat st using size 9 (5.5mm) needles. BE SURE TO GET THE GAUGE.

THE SCARF

With A, cast on 32 (40, 48) sts.

Beg with row 1 of Reversible 2-Color Garter St (see pg 26), and rep 4-row pattern until desired length, end with row 4. Bind off knitwise with A. ☞

ELONGATED CRISSCROSS SCARF

STUFF

#71662 Turquoise of Deluxe Worsted by Universal Yarn, Inc., 3½oz/100g skein, each approx 220yd/201m (wool)

One pair size 8 (5mm) knitting needles OR SIZE

TO GET THE GAUGE

Shown on page 25.

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 8 (10, 12)"/20 (25.5, 30.5)cm wide, knit to desired length.

GAUGE

18 sts and 22 rows to 4"/10cm over pat st using size 8 (5mm) needles. BE SURE TO GET THE GAUGE.

THE SCARF

Cast on 36 (44, 52) sts. Beg with row 1 of Elongated Crisscross Pat (see pg 26), working multiple of 8 stitches across row 4 (5, 6) times with 2 edge sts each side as indicated in pattern. Rep 12-row pattern until desired length, end with row 4. Bind off. ☞

FAGGOTED SCARF

STUFF

#51738 Carrot of Deluxe Worsted by Universal Yarn, Inc., 3½oz/100g skein, each approx 220yd/201m (wool)

One pair size 8 (5mm) knitting needles OR SIZE TO GET THE GAUGE

Shown on page 25.

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 8 (10, 12)"/20 (25.5, 30.5)cm wide, knit to desired length.

GAUGE

16 sts and 24 rows to 4"/10 cm over pat st using size 8 (5mm) needles. BE SURE TO GET THE GAUGE.

THE SCARF

Cast on 32 (40, 48) sts.

Beg with pattern row of Faggoting Pat (see pg 26), working multiple of 2 stitches across row 15 (19, 23) times, with 1 edge st each side as indicated in pattern. Rep pattern row until desired length. Bind off. ☞

SEEDED RIB SCARF

STUFF

#71662 Turquoise of Deluxe Worsted by Universal Yarn, Inc., 3½oz/100g skein, each approx 220yd/201m (wool)

One pair size 8 (5mm) knitting needles OR SIZE TO GET THE GAUGE

Shown on page 24.

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 8½ (10½, 12¼)"/21.5 (26.5, 31)cm wide, knit to desired length.

GAUGE

18 sts and 30 rows to 4"/10 cm over st pat using size 8 (5mm) needles. BE SURE TO GET THE GAUGE.

THE SCARF

Cast on 39 (47, 55) sts.

Beg with row 1 of Seeded Rib Pat (see pg 26), working multiple of 4 stitches across row 9 (11, 13) times, plus 3 sts as indicated in pattern. Rep 2-row pattern until desired length, end with row 2. Bind off. ☞

4-ST GARTER & 4 x 4 REVERSIBLE CABLES SCARF

STUFF

#41798 Lemon of Deluxe Worsted by Universal Yarn, Inc., 3½oz/100g skein, each

approx 220yd/201m (wool)

One pair size 8 (5mm) knitting needles OR SIZE TO GET THE GAUGE

Shown on page 25.

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 8 (9¾, 11¾)"/20 (25, 30)" wide, knit to desired length.

GAUGE

26 sts and 28 rows to 4"/10cm over st pat using size 8 (5mm) needles.

BE SURE TO GET THE GAUGE.

THE SCARF

Cast on 52 (64, 76) sts.

Beg with row 1 of 4-st Garter St and 4 x 4 Reversible Cables Pat (see pg 26), working multiple of 12 stitches across row 4 (5, 6) times, with 4 extra sts as indicated in pattern. Rep 10-row pattern until desired length, bind off as stated in directions. ⌘

STUFF

#61633 Greenery of Deluxe Worsted by Universal Yarn, Inc., 3½oz/100g skein, each approx 220yd/201m (wool)

One pair size 8 (5mm) knitting needles OR SIZE

TO GET THE GAUGE

Shown on page 25.

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 8 (10, 12)"/20 (25.5, 30.5)cm wide, knit to desired length.

GAUGE

■ 16 sts and 20 rows to 4"/10 cm over pat st using size 8 (5mm) needles.

BE SURE TO GET THE GAUGE.

THE SCARF

■ Cast on 32 (40, 48) sts. Beg with row 1 of Simple Brioche Pat (see pg 26), working multiple of 2 stitches across row 16 (20, 24) times. Rep row 2 until desired length. Bind off as stated in directions. ⌘

CABLES & LACE SCARF

STUFF

#61633 Greenery of Deluxe Worsted by Universal Yarn, Inc., 3½oz/100g skein, each approx 220yd/201m (wool)

One pair size 8 (5mm) knitting needles

OR SIZE TO GET THE GAUGE

Shown on page 24.

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 8 (9½, 11)"/20 (24, 28)cm wide, knit to desired length.

GAUGE

23 sts and 28 rows to 4"/10cm over pat st using size 8 (5mm) needles.

BE SURE TO GET THE GAUGE.

THE SCARF

Cast on 46 (55, 64) sts. Beg with row 1 of Cables and Lace Rib Pat (see pg 26), working multiple of 9 stitches across row 4 (5, 6) times, with 3 edge sts both sides AND 4 extra sts as indicated in pattern. Rep 8-row pattern until desired length, end with row 4. Bind off. ⌘

STUFF

#91468 Sunkist Coral of Deluxe Worsted (A) by Universal Yarn, Inc., 3½oz/100g skein,

each approx 220yd/201m (wool)

#10 Dazzling of Rebecca (B) by Universal Yarn, Inc., 1¾oz/50g skein, each approx 70yd/64m (polyamide/acrylic/mohair)

Two size 9 (5.5mm) double pointed needles (dpns) OR one circular needle OR SIZE TO GET THE GAUGE

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 8 (10, 12½)"/20 (25.5, 32)cm

GAUGE

20 sts and 32 rows to 4"/10cm over pat st using size 9 (5.5mm) needles

BE SURE TO GET THE GAUGE.

THE SCARF

■ With A, cast on 39 (51, 63) sts Beg with row 1 of 2-Color Mini-welt with Slip st Stripes Pat (see pg 26), working multiple of 6 stitches across row 6 (8, 10) times, with 3 extra sts as indicated in pattern. Rep 4-row pattern until desired length, bind off with A. ⌘

#1900 Ebony of Deluxe Worsted (A) by Universal Yarn, Inc., 3½oz/100g skein, each approx 220yd/201m (wool)

#906 Landscape of Deluxe Worsted Magic (B) by Universal Yarn, Inc., 3½oz/100g skein, each approx 220yd/201m (wool)

Two size 8 (5mm) double pointed needles (dpns) OR one circular needle OR SIZE TO GET THE GAUGE

Shown on page 25.

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 8 (10, 12)"/20 (25.5, 30.5)cm wide, knit to desired length.

GAUGE

30 sts and 48 rows to 4"/10cm over st pat using size 8 (5mm) needles, measured across solid side.

BE SURE TO GET THE GAUGE.

THE SCARF

Cast on 61 (75, 91) sts with A.

Beg with row 1 of Double-Knit Solid and Stripes Pat Pat (see pg 26), working multiple of 2 sts across row 30 (37, 45) times, with 1 extra st to make an odd number. Rep 6-row pattern until desired length, end with row 1.

Bind off tightly with A.

#11835 Purple of Deluxe Worsted (A) by Universal Yarn, Inc., 3½oz/100g skein,

each approx 220yd/201m (wool)

#906 Landscape of Deluxe Worsted Magic (B) by Universal Yarn, Inc., 3½oz/100g skein, each approx 220yd/201m (wool)

Two size 8 (5mm) double pointed needles (dpns) OR one circular needle OR SIZE TO GET THE GAUGE

Shown on page 24.

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 8½ (10, 12½)"/20.5 (25.5, 32)cm wide, knit to desired length.

GAUGE

28 sts and 32 rows to 4"/10cm over pat st, using size 8 (5mm) needles.

BE SURE TO GET THE GAUGE.

THE SCARF

Cast on 59 (71, 87) sts with A.

Beg with row 1 of Double-Knit Horizontal and Vertical Stripes Pat (see pg 96), working multiple of 4 stitches across row 14 (17, 21) times, with 3 extra sts as indicated in pattern. Rep 4-row pattern until desired length, end with row 2. Bind off as stated in directions.

#1900 Ebony of Deluxe Worsted (A) by Universal Yarn, Inc., 3½oz/100g skein, each approx 220yd/201m (wool)

#29 Spring of Ever (B) by Universal Yarn, Inc., 1¾oz/50g skein, each approx 109yd/100m (polyamide/wool/acrylic/glitter)

Two size 9 (5.5mm) double pointed needles (dpns) OR one circular needle OR SIZE TO GET THE GAUGE

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 8 (10, 12)"/20 (25.5, 30.5) cm wide, knit to desired length.

GAUGE

32 sts and 32 rows to 4"/10cm over pat st, using size 9 (5.5mm) needles.

BE SURE TO GET THE GAUGE.

THE SCARF

Cast on 65 (81, 97) sts with A.

Beg with row 1 of Double Knit Stripes and Dots (see pg 96), working multiple of 4 stitches across row 16 (20, 24) times, with 1 extra st as indicated in pattern. Rep 8-row pattern until desired length, end with row 2. Bind off with A.

#11835 Purple of Deluxe Worsted (A) by Universal Yarn, Inc., 3½ oz/100g skein, each approx 220yd/201m (wool)

#91468 Sunkist Coral (B)

Two size 8 (5mm) double pointed needles (dpns) OR 1 circular needle OR SIZE TO GET THE GAUGE

Shown on page 25.

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 8 (10, 12)"/20 (25.5, 30.5) cm wide, knit to desired length.

GAUGE

32 sts and 48 rows to 4"/10cm over pat st using size 8 (5mm) needles.

BE SURE TO GET THE GAUGE.

THE SCARF

Cast on 64 (80, 96) sts with A.

Beg with row 1 of Double-Knit Diamond Pat (see pg 96), working multiple of 8 stitches across row 8 (10, 12) times. Rep 12-row pattern until desired length, end and bind off as stated in directions.
